DISCUSSION REGARDING DOMESTIC WELLS DRILLED ON LAND UNDER 10 ACRES

The Brewster County Groundwater Conservation District (“District”) invites you to a discussion with the Board of Directors, Landowners, Well Drillers, Realtors, and interested parties; to a discussion regarding the current rules on Domestic wells on property under 10 acres.

The current rules § **5.401 Exempt Wells** state that for a well to be exempt (for this discussion) “it must be on 10 acre tracts, or larger, for domestic or livestock purposes, and not pump more than 25,000 gallons of groundwater a day”, etc....

There are currently provisions allowing for wells under 10 acre tracts that are up for discussion.
